The price of a gravestone is primarily determined by the granite color, overall size and the textures used, plus whatever applicable cemetery charges are involved. Prices can range from under \$1,000 for flat markers and simple upright monuments to \$10,000 and higher for more elaborate monuments. There is a very solid, concrete foundation used below upright monuments so there is very little problem with monuments tipping, shifting, or becoming un-level.
